- Creating and communicating the tournament schedule
- Looking for sponsors who would be willing to donate prizes
- Planning after-tournament gathering/party

Day of:

- Setting up fields & field food
- Being the point of contact for the day of the event
- Collecting game scores and spirit scores
- Hosting the after-tournament gathering and awarding prizes
